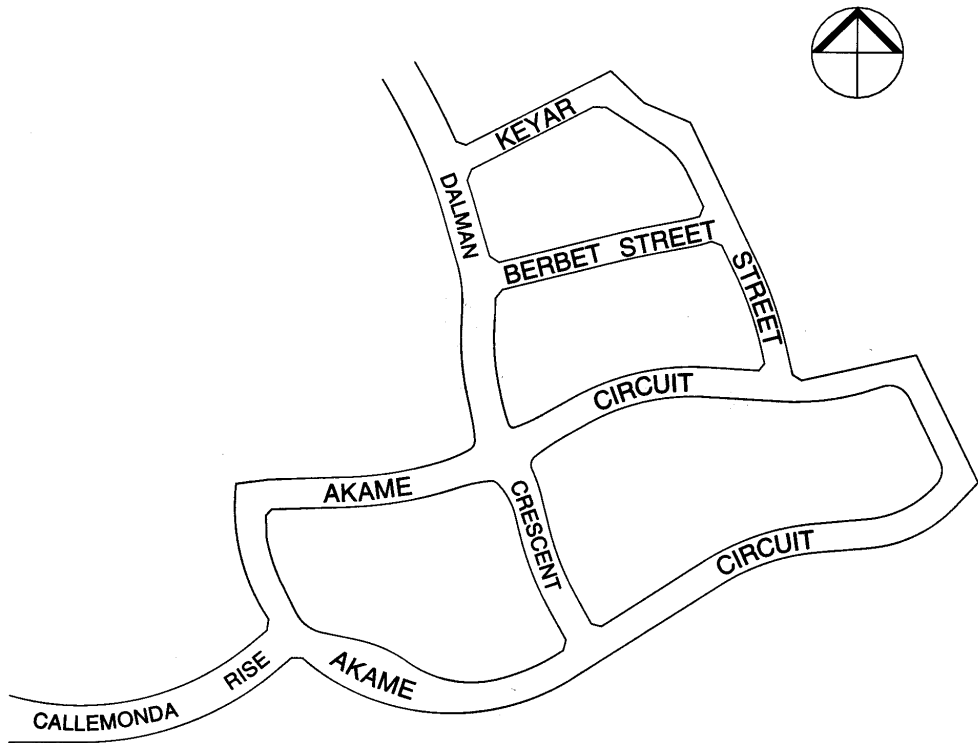

NAME	ORIGIN	SIGNIFICANCE
Akame Circuit	Word from the Meryam Mir language, one of three languages spoken in the Torres Strait.	'Akame' means 'surprise'.
Keyar Street	Word from the Meryam Mir language, one of three languages spoken in the Torres Strait.	'Keyar' means 'crayfish'.
Berbet Street	Word from the Meryam Mir language, one of three languages spoken in the Torres Strait.	'Berbet' means 'sibling or cousin'.
