

Evelyn Parker Place	Evelyn Parker (1907-1993)	Mayor, Community Service After a lifetime of devoted service as a teacher, and 20 years' service as a Subiaco City Councillor, Evelyn Parker created history by becoming the first woman Mayor in WA. During World War II, she played a major role in the operations of the Red Cross and the service canteens. She was also a supporter of Sister Kate's Home, was on the committee of WA's first free children's library and engaged in many hospital and club activities. She was awarded an OBE and a Community Service Award in the 1975 Citizen of the Year Awards.
