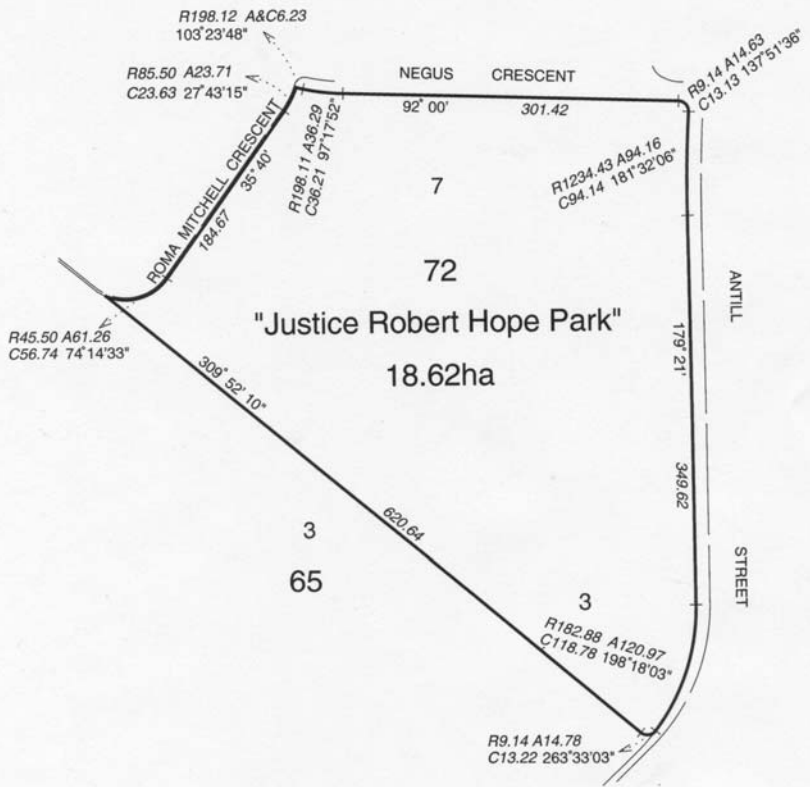

Justice Hope's Committee of Inquiry into the National Estate led to the acknowledgement of the idea of the National Estate and the concept that things should be kept as part of our heritage.
