Standard 3, Part 12, Rule 6

6. Recording attendance times

An officer must record the time of their arrival and departure to and from the workplace each day at the actual time they arrive or depart unless they temporarily leave the workplace during normal working hours on official business. Unless otherwise provided by this Part, this does not apply to:

- a) officers who, by reason of their rate of pay are not entitled to overtime duty and those who have been exempted due to work requirements, by the relevant Chief Executive in consultation with the Commissioner; and
- b) any other officer or class of officer who has been exempted due to work requirements, by the Commissioner.

However, the exemption specified in Rule 6a of Rule 6 (Standard 3, Part 12) does not apply to an officer that participates in flextime or similar arrangements for flexible working arrangements under an agency certified agreement or industrial instrument.

The exemption of any officer from this Rule does not authorise them to be absent from duty or leave their place of duty within ordinary weekly hours except on official business.
