

Legal Profession (Bar Association Council Fees) Determination 2006 (No 1)

Disallowable Instrument DI2006-143

made under the

Legal Profession Act 2006, Section 84(2) – Determination of fees by law society council and bar association council

1. Name of instrument

This instrument is the Legal Profession (Bar Association Council Fees) Determination 2006 (No 1).

2. Commencement

This instrument commences on 1 July 2006.

3. Determination of fees

The fee payable for an application for the grant or renewal of a barrister practising certificate, for the level of seniority listed in Column 1 of Schedule 1, is the amount listed for that item in Column 2 of that Schedule.

4. Payment of fee

A fee listed in Schedule 1 is payable to the ACT Bar Association by the person requesting the barrister practising certificate.

A fee may be paid by instalments if the person requesting the barrister practising certificate makes a written request to do so and the ACT Bar Association agrees in writing.

5. Goods and services tax

Barrister practising certificate fees are exempt from payment of GST.
