1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Building (Asbestos code –asbestos removal control plan) Determination 2006.*

2 Commencement

This instrument commences the day after notification.

3 Asbestos code

In accordance with section 139B (1) of the *Building Act 2004* (the Act), I approve the following as the asbestos code for the purposes of section 29 (1) (d) of the Act.

The code of practice for an *asbestos removal control plan* (as defined by the Act) is that the *asbestos removal control plan* is to contain, as a minimum, the following information-

- the method proposed to be used to remove the asbestos;
- the approximate quantity and kind of asbestos to be removed;
- the equipment proposed to be used to remove the asbestos, including any personal protective equipment; and
- details of a program (prepared in accordance with the NOHSC Code of Practice for the Safe Removal of Asbestos, published by the Office of the Australian Safety and Compensation Council) for monitoring airborne asbestos.
