1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) (Defined Rights Conditions) Determination 2006 (No 1).

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after notification.

3 Approval

I determine that the conditions contained in Schedule 1 are the defined rights conditions for a ballot of defined rights for transferable leased taxi licences to be held on 19 April 2006.

SCHEDULE 1

DEFINED RIGHTS CONDITIONS TRANSFERABLE LEASED TAXI LICENCES

- 1. Unless otherwise approved by the Road Transport Authority (the Authority) under clauses 4 and 5, a defined right for a transferable leased taxi licence allocated to a person in a ballot of defined rights ends **45 days** after the day of the ballot.
- Unless otherwise approved by the Authority under clauses 4 and 5, a defined right for a transferable leased taxi licence offered to a person on a reserve list of ballot entrants ends 45 days after the day the person accepts the offer of the defined right.
- 3. A person who is the holder of a defined right pursuant to clause 1 or 2, may apply to the Authority for an extension of the relevant defined right period on the following terms:
 - (a) the application must:
 - (i) be in writing,
 - (ii) be received by the Authority prior to the expiration of the relevant defined period referred to in clause 1 and 2 (as applicable), and
 - (iii) specify the additional period of time (not exceeding 60 days from the date of the application) sought by the applicant and the reasons for the specified period of time; and
 - (b) the application must include evidence of the applicant's having substantially commenced and progressed the following:
 - (i) the process of becoming accredited to operate a taxi service, and
 - (ii) obtaining and fitting out a vehicle in accordance with the vehicle standards for taxis under the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulations 2000.*
- 4. The Authority may approve an application for an extended defined right if the Authority believes, on reasonable grounds, that the person intends to operate a vehicle under a transferable leased taxi licence and the additional time is necessary to enable the holder of the defined right to:

- (a) complete the process of becoming accredited to operate a taxi service, and/or
- (b) obtain and fit out a vehicle in accordance with the vehicle standards for taxis under the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulations* 2000.
- 5. If the Authority approves an application to extend the defined right period:
 - (a) it will notify the applicant what will be the **extended defined right period**,
 - (b) the approval will specify the date on which the extended defined right ends, and
 - (c) the applicant must pay the determined fee for the issue of the extended defined right period.
- 6. A person who is the holder of a defined right must, before the day the defined right period or extended defined right period, if applicable, ends:
 - (a) apply to the Authority to be issued with a transferable leased taxi licence; and
 - (b) either:
 - (i) pay the determined annual fee for a transferable leased taxi licence, or
 - (ii) if paying the annual fee in quarterly instalments, pay the first instalment.

Notes

- Under the Road Transport (General) (Taxi Licence and Stand-by Hire Permit Fees)
 Determination 2006 (No 1), the fee for the issue of an extension of defined right period is \$500.
- ii. Under the Road Transport (General) (Taxi Licence and Stand-by Hire Permit Fees) Determination 2006 (No 1), if a holder of an extended defined right is issued with a transferable leased taxi licence before the extended defined right ends, the determined fee for the issue of an extension of defined right period must be refunded to the person. If the holder of an extended defined right is not issued with a transferable leased taxi licence before the extended defined right period ends, the determined fee for the issue of an extension of defined right period is not refundable to the person.
