1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Tree Protection (Criteria for Tree Management Precincts)*Determination 2006 (No 1)

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after notification.

3 Determination

- (1) The Minister may declare an area of leased land as a Tree Management Precinct if:
 - (a) the Minister is satisfied that a significant threat to the urban forest values exists or is likely to exist in the near future (for example, due to existing or projected high levels of development activity; or in an area of low or reducing level of tree canopy cover); or
 - (b) the area is entered on the Heritage Register under the Heritage Act 2004; or
 - (c) the area is a new estate development that is subject to construction activity.
- (2) In declaring an area to be a Tree Management Precinct, the Minister may have regard to the broader strategic planning objectives of the Territory Plan and associated urban planning by the ACT Planning and Land Authority
