- (g) after ‘Master of Technology’
insert **Master of Technology in Information Systems**
Master of Technology in Network Computing
Master of Technology in Software Engineering

(d) after ‘Graduate Diploma in Human Resource Management’
insert **Graduate Diploma in Inclusive Education**

5. Section 5 of the Principal Statute is amended as follows:

insert **Graduate Certificate in Forensic Studies**

(b) after ‘Graduate Certificate in Human Resource Management’

(c) after ‘Graduate Certificate in Professional Studies’
insert **Graduate Certificate in Professional Writing**

(d) after ‘Graduate Certificate in Regional and Local Government Management’
insert **Graduate Certificate in Scaffolding English for Speakers of Other Languages**
