### Citation

1. This Statute may be cited as the University of Canberra (University Seal) Statute 2007.

### Commencement

2. This Statute commences on the date of notification.

## Repeal

**3.** The University of Canberra University Seal Statute 1992 is repealed.

### **Definitions**

- **4.** In this Statute, unless the contrary intention appears:
  - "seal" means the seal of the University referred to in section 4 of the University of Canberra Act 1989 (ACT);
    - "Secretary" means:
      - (a) the Secretary of Council; or
      - (b) an officer of the University appointed under section 7.

### Documents to which seal is to be affixed

**5.** Where the Council has, under section 4 of the University of Canberra Act 1989 (ACT), authorised the use of the seal on:

- (a) the certificate or other like document (in this section called "testamur") issued to a person as evidence that the person has been admitted to a degree, diploma or certificate of the University; and
- (b) each Statute made by the Council; and
- (c) any other document which is approved by the Council and which is required to be under the seal;

the Secretary must affix the seal to each such testamur, Statute or other document.

## Affixing of seal to other documents

- 6. (1) Where a document, other than a document referred to in section 4, is required to be under the seal, the Chancellor or the Vice-Chancellor may, acting on behalf of the Council, direct the Secretary to affix the seal to that document.
  - Where the seal is affixed under subsection (1) at the direction of the Chancellor or the Vice-Chancellor, the Secretary must, at the first opportunity, report to the Council the action so taken.
  - (3) Where the seal is affixed in accordance with this section, the affixing is taken to have been authorised by the Council.

#### Attestation

7. The affixing of the seal to any document must be attested by at least two of the Chancellor or the Vice Chancellor or the Secretary.

### **Appointment of person to be Secretary**

**8.** The Vice-Chancellor may appoint an officer of the University to be the Secretary for the purposes of this Statute.

The foregoing Statute is made by Council under section 40 of the *University of Canberra Act* 1989.
