

Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Approval of Protective Helmets for Motorbike Riders Determination 2009 (No 1)

Disallowable Instrument DI 2009-2

made under the

Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulation 2000 s66 (1)(c) power to approve a protective helmet for motorbike riders as an approved motorbike helmet

1. Name of Instrument

This instrument is the *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Approval of Protective Helmets for Motorbike Riders Determination 2009 (No 1)*.

2. Revocation of Previous Instrument

Instrument No 91 of 2000 (as notified on the ACT Government Legislation Register) is revoked.

3. Determination

I determine that the following kinds of protective helmets for motorbike riders are approved by the Road Transport Authority as approved motorbike helmets:

1. A protective helmet that has applied to it the certification trade mark of which the Standards Association of Australia is the registered proprietor under the Trade Marks Act 1955 of the Commonwealth together with the letter and figures “E33”;
2. A protective helmet that has applied to it the certification trade mark of which the Standards Association of Australia is the registered proprietor under the Trade Marks Act 1955 of the Commonwealth together with the letter and figures “E43”;
3. A protective helmet that has applied to it the certification trade mark of which the Standards Association of Australia is the registered proprietor under the Trade Marks Act 1955 of the Commonwealth together with the figures “1698”;
4. A protective helmet that has applied to it the letters and figures “AS E33” or the letters and figures “AS E43”.

4. Commencement

This instrument commences the day after notification.
