1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Education (School Boards of School-Related Institutions) Early Childhood Schools Determination* 2009

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the first day after which it is notified.

3 Composition

I determine the composition of the school boards of Early Childhood Schools as school-related institutions, to be as follows:

- (a) the principal of the school
- (b) 1 member (the *appointed member*) appointed by the Chief Executive as the appointed member; and
- (c) 1 member (the *staff member*) elected by the staff of the school and appointed by the Chief Executive; and
- (d) 1 member (the *child care member*) nominated by the child care provider at the school and appointed by the Chief Executive; and
- (e) 2 members (the *parents and citizens members*) elected by the parents and citizens association of the school and appointed by the Chief Executive; and
- (f) no more than 2 members (the *community or government agency service members*) nominated by their employer and appointed by the Chief Executive; and
- (g) 1 member (the *board appointed member*) (if any) appointed by the board.

A person is eligible to be elected or appointed as the staff member only if the person is employed as a member of the staff of the school.

4 Quorum

Business may be carried out at a meeting of the school board only if 3 or more members are present and at least 1 of the members present is either the staff member or the principal and at least 1 of the members present is a parents and citizens member.

5 Voting rights

The board appointed member is a non-voting member of the school board.

6 Period of appointment

The appointed member, staff member, child care member, parents and citizens members and community or government agency service members are appointed for the prescribed period.

The board appointed member may be appointed by the school board for a term (not longer than 12 months) to be decided by the school board.
