1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the Attorney General (Fees) Amendment Determination 2010 (No 2).

2 Commencement

This instrument takes effect on 7 October 2010.

3 Amendments

This instrument amends the Attorney General (Fees) Determination 2010 (DI2010-107) by:

(a) Amending schedule 1 to insert at the bottom of the table:

419 For the application for issue of or renewal of a motor vehicle repair licence, for a period of up to 12 months, where the licensee will have five employees involved in repair work or less. \$251.00

Explanatory Note: This is a new fee. This fee is consistent with the previous fee under the Motor Vehicle Service and Repair Industry Code of Practice.

420 For the application for issue of or renewal of a motor vehicle repair licence, for a period of up to 12 months, where the licensee will have between six and twenty employees involved in repair work. \$310.00

Explanatory Note: This is a new fee. This fee is consistent with the previous fee under the Motor Vehicle Service and Repair Industry Code of Practice.

421 For the application for issue of or renewal of a motor vehicle repair licence, for a period of up to 12 months, where the licensee will have twenty one employees or greater involved in repair work. \$358.00

Explanatory Note: This is a new fee. This fee is consistent with the previous fee under the Motor Vehicle Service and Repair Industry Code of Practice.
