

Road Transport (General) Application of Road Transport Legislation Declaration 2010 (No 9)

Road Transport (General) Act 1999, section 13 (Power to exclude vehicles, persons or animals from road transport legislation)

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Road Transport (General) Application of Road Transport Legislation Declaration 2010 (No 9)*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 9 November 2010.

3 Declaration

I declare that the relevant provisions do not apply to the driver of a designated vehicle being driven for the purposes of attending and participating in the funeral service to be held for Beb Fox at Norwood Park Crematorium on 9 November 2010.

4 Period of effect of declaration

The declaration under clause 3 has effect between 8.00am and 6.00pm on 9 November 2010.

5 Definitions

In this instrument:

designated vehicle means a vehicle with any of the following registration numbers:

- (a) YFM 06A
- (b) YDF 97T
- (c) GM 029

registration number—see the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulation 2000*, dictionary.

relevant provision means—

- (a) the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Act 1999*, section 21 (3); or
- (b) the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulation 2000*, section 33 (7).

6 Expiry

This instrument expires on 10 November 2010.
