## 1. Name of Instrument

This Instrument is the Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Maximum Fares for Taxi Services Determination 2010 (No 1).

## 2. Revocation of Previous Instrument

This instrument revokes Disallowable Instrument DI2009-145, notified on 30 June 2009.

## 3. Determination

I determine that the maximum fares relating to the hiring or use of a taxi are as specified in the Schedule.

## 4. Payment of Fare

A fare to which this determination applies is payable by a customer for using taxi services and is payable to the taxi driver.
