Legal Profession Act 2006, section 84(2) -- Determination of fees by law society council and bar council

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Legal Profession (Bar Council Fees) Determination 2011 (No 1)*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day it is notified.

3 Determination of fees

The fee payable for an application for the grant or renewal of a practising certificate, for the level of seniority listed in column 1 of the attached schedule, the amount listed in column 2 of the attached schedule.

4 Payment of fees

A fee listed in the schedule is payable to the ACT Bar Association by the person requesting the barrister practising certificate.

A fee may be paid by instalments if the person requesting the barrister practising certificate makes a written request to do so and the ACT Bar Association agrees in writing.

5 Goods and services tax (GST)

Barrister practising certificates are exempt from the payment of GST.

6 Revocation

This instrument revokes Disallowable Instrument DI2008 – 54.
