## Electoral Act 1992, s 8 (Determination of Fees)

- 1. This determination may be cited as *Electoral (Fees) Determination 2012*.
- 2. This determination takes effect on the day after the determination is notified under the *Legislation Act 2001*.
- 3. The ACT Electoral Commission REVOKES disallowable instrument No. DI2011-181 (Electoral (Fees) Determination 2011).
