

Education (School Boards of Schools in Special Circumstances) University of Canberra High School Kaleen Determination 2012*

Disallowable instrument DI2012–2

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Education (School Boards of Schools in Special Circumstances) University of Canberra High School Kaleen Determination 2012*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the first day after which it is notified.

3 Composition

I determine the composition of the School Board of the University of Canberra High School Kaleen, a School in Special Circumstances, to be as follows:

- (a) the principal of the school;
- (b) one member (***the appointed member***) appointed by the Director-General as the appointed member;
- (c) two members (***the staff members***) elected by staff of the school and appointed by the Director-General;
- (d) three members (***the parents and citizens members***) elected by the parents and citizens association of the school and appointed by the Director-General;
- (e) two students (***the student members***) elected by the students and appointed by the Director-General;
- (f) one member (***the University of Canberra member***) nominated by the University of Canberra and appointed by the Director-General; and
- (g) one or more members (***the board appointed members***) elected by the board for a term (not longer than 12 months) decided by the board.

4 Quorum

Business may be carried out at a meeting of the school board only if three or

more members are present and at least one of the members present is a *staff member* and at least one of the members present is a *parents and citizens member*.

5 Voting rights

All members of the board have equal voting rights, except the board appointed members (if any), who are non-voting members.

6 Period of appointment

All members except the principal and board appointed members (if any) are appointed for the prescribed period, as defined in section 37 of the Act.
