1 Name of instrument

This instrument is *the Public Health (Fees) Determination 2012 (No 1)*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 30 September 2012.

3 Determination of fees

The fee payable in respect of each matter listed in column 2 of a schedule is the amount listed for that item in column 4.

4 Payment of fees

A fee listed in a schedule is payable to the Territory by the person identified in column 3 of a schedule.

5 Refunding of fees

Column 5 of the schedules specifies what amount, if any, of a fee identified in column 4 is non-refundable. A non-refundable amount is included to cover the costs associated with the processing and administration of an application.

6 Revocation

This instrument revokes DI2011-242 on commencement.
