

Road Transport (General) CTP Regulator Levy Determination 2013 (No 1)

Disallowable instrument DI 2013–17

made under the

Road Transport (General) Act 1999, section 96 (Determination of fees, charges and other amounts)

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Road Transport (General) CTP Regulator Levy Determination 2013 (No 1)*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences upon notification on the ACT Legislation Register and applies in respect to a ‘compulsory third-party policy’ issued under the *Road Transport (Third-Party Insurance) Act 2008 (CTP Act)* that commences on or after 1 May 2013.

3 Determination of fees

The CTP regulator determines the levy set out in this determination. The CTP Regulator Levy shall be \$1.00.

4 Payment of fees

The CTP Regulator Levy to which this determination applies is payable in respect of each ‘compulsory third-party policy’ for a vehicle (other than a trailer) registered by the road transport authority, or in respect of a trader’s plate issued by the road transport authority, under the provisions of

1. the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulation 2000*, made under the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Act 1999*; or
2. the *Interstate Road Transport Act 1985* of the Commonwealth.

The levy is payable to the CTP regulator in relation to premium amounts collected by the road transport authority on behalf of a CTP insurer under the CTP Act.
