# Road Transport (General) (Garbage and waste disposal) Exemption 2013 (No 1)

Disallowable instrument DI2013—54

made under the

Road Transport (General) Act 1999, section 13 (Power to exclude vehicles, persons or animals from road transport legislation)

## 1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Road Transport (General) (Garbage and waste disposal) Exemption 2013 (No 1).* 

#### 2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 9 May 2013.

#### 3 Declaration

- (1) I declare that Australian Road Rules 98 (One-way signs) and 100 (No entry signs) do not apply to the driver of a garbage or waste disposal truck on Astrolabe Street, in the Division of Red Hill, while the driver is engaged in the collection of waste or garbage in that street on Fridays between 7:00am and 4:30pm.
- (2) This exemption applies only when the garbage or waste disposal truck is displaying a flashing light, and the driver is acting safely.

Note: Australian Road Rule 313A provides that another law of this jurisdiction may provide that a provision of the Australian Road Rules that is specified in the other law does not apply to the driver of a garbage or waste disposal truck while:

- (a) the driver is engaged in the collection of waste or garbage; and
- (b) the driver is unable to comply with the provision; and
- (c) the garbage or waste disposal truck is displaying a flashing light; and
- (d) the driver is acting safely.

### 4 Expiry

This instrument expires on 8 May 2016.
