

# Road Transport (General) Application of Road Transport Legislation Declaration 2016 (No 11)

Disallowable instrument DI2016—273

made under the

**Road Transport (General) Act 1999, section 13 (Power to exclude vehicles, persons or animals from road transport legislation)**

## 1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Road Transport (General) Application of Road Transport Legislation Declaration 2016 (No 11)*.

## 2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 11 November 2016.

## 3 Third-party insurance declaration

- (1) The *Road Transport (Third-Party Insurance) Act 2008* does not apply to a designated vehicle while being used to participate in a stage of the Southern Cross Golden Anniversary Rally for any period beginning when an event official declares (in whatever manner the event official describes) the stage active for a testing session, media event, corporate event day or rally competition and ending when an event official declares the stage inactive.

*Note* A reference to an Act includes a reference to the statutory instruments made or in force under the Act, including any regulation (see Legislation Act, s 104).

- (2) However subclause (1) does not apply if the designated vehicle is—
  - (a) covered under a policy of compulsory third-party insurance of a place other than the ACT or under a law of the Commonwealth; or
  - (b) subject to coverage under a compulsory motor vehicle or trailer accident compensation scheme of a place other than the ACT or of the Commonwealth.

#### 4 Declaration – other road transport legislation

I declare that:

- the *Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Act 1999*;
- the *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Act 1999*; and
- the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Act 1999*,

do not apply to an entrant vehicle or the driver of an entrant vehicle, while participating in a special stage of the Southern Cross Golden Anniversary Rally for any period beginning when an event official declares (in whatever manner the event official describes) the stage active for a testing session, media event, corporate event day or rally competition and ending when an event official declares the stage inactive.

#### 5 Definitions

In this instrument:

***designated vehicle*** means any of the following vehicles:

- (a) a registered entrant motor vehicle;
- (b) a registered promotional or official vehicle;
- (c) an unidentified motor vehicle;
- (d) an uninsured motor vehicle.

***entrant vehicle*** means:

- (a) a vehicle entered for competition for the Southern Cross Golden Anniversary Rally, to take part in the stages; or
- (b) a promotional or official vehicle being used for promotional or official purposes during the special stages.

***event*** means the Southern Cross Golden Anniversary Rally.

***event official*** means an official for the event who holds an official's licence from the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd that authorises the official to declare event stages active or inactive.

***registered*** means registered under the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Act 1999*.

***special stage***, for the event, means a road or road related area identified for the event on the attached map:

- Stage 1 – Kowen Forest
- Stage 2 – Kowen Forest

***unidentified motor vehicle***—see the *Road Transport (Third-Party Insurance) Act 2008*, section 62.

*uninsured motor vehicle*—see the *Road Transport (Third-Party Insurance) Act 2008*, section 60.

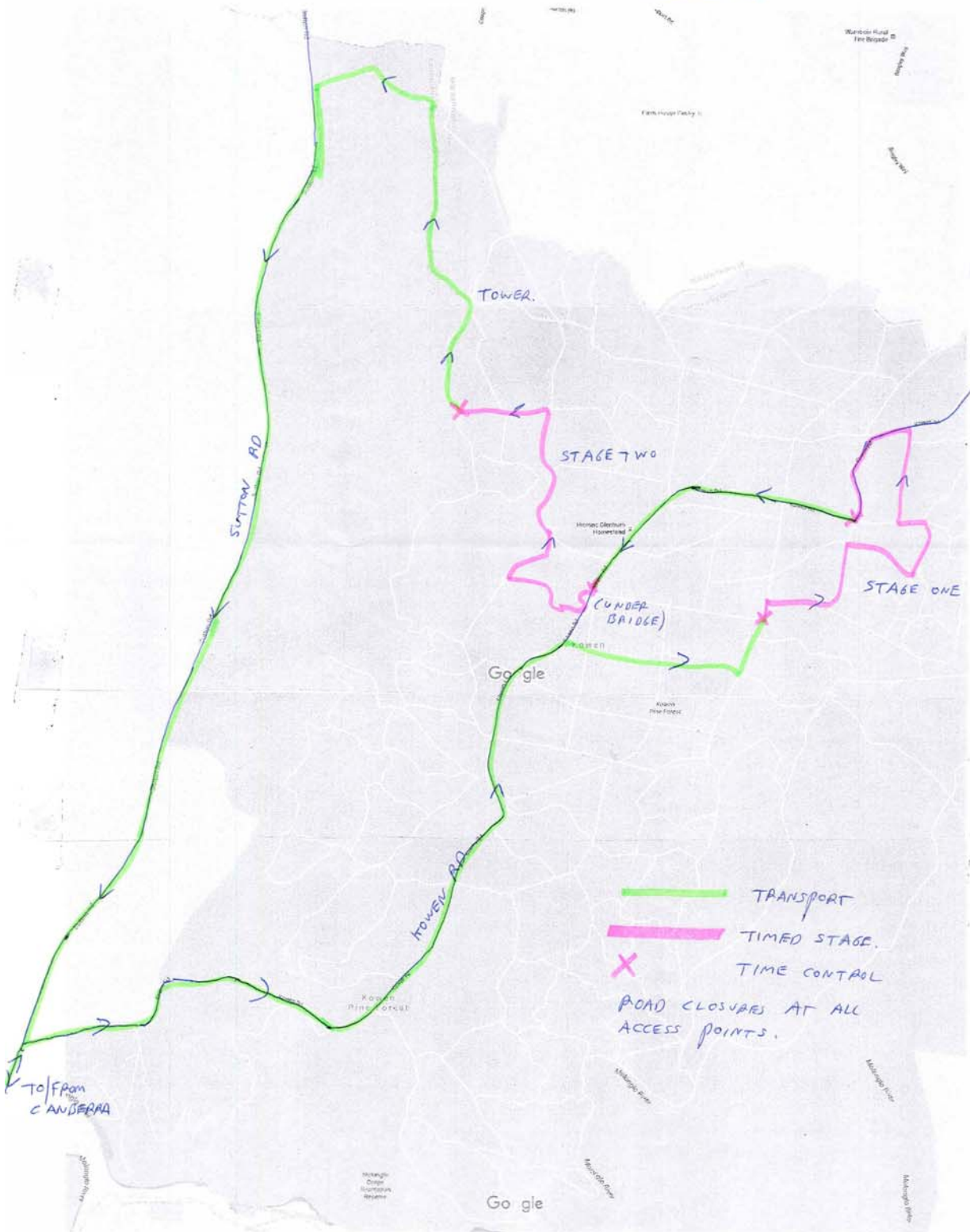
