Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Maximum Fares for Taxi Services Determination 2017 (No 1)*

Disallowable Instrument DI 2017 - 247

made under the

Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Act 2001, section 60 (Power to determine taxi fares)

1. Name of Instrument

This instrument is the *Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Maximum Fares for Taxi Services Determination 2017 (No 1)*.

2. Commencement

This instrument commences the day after notification.

3. Determination

I determine that the maximum fares relating to the hiring or use of a taxi are as specified in the schedule.

4. Payment of Fare

A fare to which this determination applies is payable by a customer for using taxi services and is payable to the taxi driver.

5. Revocation

This instrument revokes the *Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Maximum Fares for Taxi Services Determination 2015 DI2015-187*.

This fee is not applicable to rank and hail hirings or bookings made other than through a transport booking service.</p> <p>A premium service must include a service guarantee on a passenger's plane, bus or train ticket where delays in the service impact on the passenger's travel. Details of the service guarantee, including its value, must be made available to prospective hirers (for example on a website).</p> <p>Any conditions associated with a hirer's use of the premium service, such as minimum timeframes for bookings, must also be available to hirers prior to making their booking.</p>	\$13.80
