

# Road Transport (General) Application of Road Transport Legislation Declaration 2017 (No 3)

## Disallowable instrument DI2017–29

made under the

**Road Transport (General) Act 1999, section 12 (Power to include or exclude areas in road transport legislation)**

### 1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Road Transport (General) Application of Road Transport Legislation Declaration 2017 (No 3)*.

### 2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after its notification day.

### 3 Declaration

I declare that for the period set out in section 4, the following provisions of the road transport legislation do not apply to the area identified in the schedule:

- (i) *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulation 2000* Division 2.3.6 (Ticket parking) other than sections 53 (Misuse of parking ticket machines) and 54 (Interfering with parking ticket machines etc); and
- (ii) *Australian Road Rules* rule 207 (Parking where fees are payable); and
- (iii) *Australian Road Rules* rule 211 (Park in parking bays).

*Australian Road Rules* see sections 5 & 6 of the *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulation 2000*.

### 4 Period of effect of declaration

The declaration in section 3 applies for the period 10:00pm, 6 April 2017 to 11:00am, 8 April 2017.
