

Plant Diseases (Importation Restriction Area) Declaration 2018 (No 2)

Disallowable instrument DI2018–217

made under the

Plant Diseases Act 2002, s 12 (Declaration of area subject to importation restriction)

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Plant Diseases (Importation Restriction Area) Declaration 2018 (No 2)*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after its notification day.

3 Dictionary

In this instrument:

area freedom certificate means a biosecurity certificate or interstate biosecurity certificate that certifies that a State or Territory or part of a State or Territory is known to be free of Citrus canker

citrus canker carrier means citrus plants (including fruit and leaves) and any of the following material that has come into contact with a citrus plant:

- (a) soil;
- (b) packaging;
- (c) equipment; and
- (d) machinery.

citrus plant means a plant of the genus *Citrus*, including the following species and their hybrids:

- (a) *Citrus trifoliata* L. (syn. *Poncirus trifoliata*);
- (b) *Citrus glauca* (Lindl.) Burkill (syn. *Eremocitrus glauca*); and
- (c) *Citrus australasica* F.Muell. (syn. *Microcitrus australasica*).

4 Declaration

- (1) I declare the following areas to be subject to an importation restriction (the ***declared areas***):
 - (a) Northern Territory;
 - (b) the area within a 50km radius of the Wyndham post office; and
 - (c) the areas within a 50km radius of the Kununurra post office.
- (2) Diagrams of the declared areas are shown in schedule 1.

5 Disease

This declaration relates to citrus canker caused by the bacterium *Xanthomonas citri* subsp. *citri*.

6 Importation restrictions

The restrictions in schedule 2, column 3, apply to importing into the ACT the material described in column 2 that has, at any time since 1 April 2018 been kept in or travelled through the declared areas.

7 When declaration takes effect

This declaration takes effect on the commencement day of this instrument.

8 Revocation

This instrument revokes the *Plant Diseases (Importation Restriction Area) Declaration 2018 (No 1)* (DI2018-86).

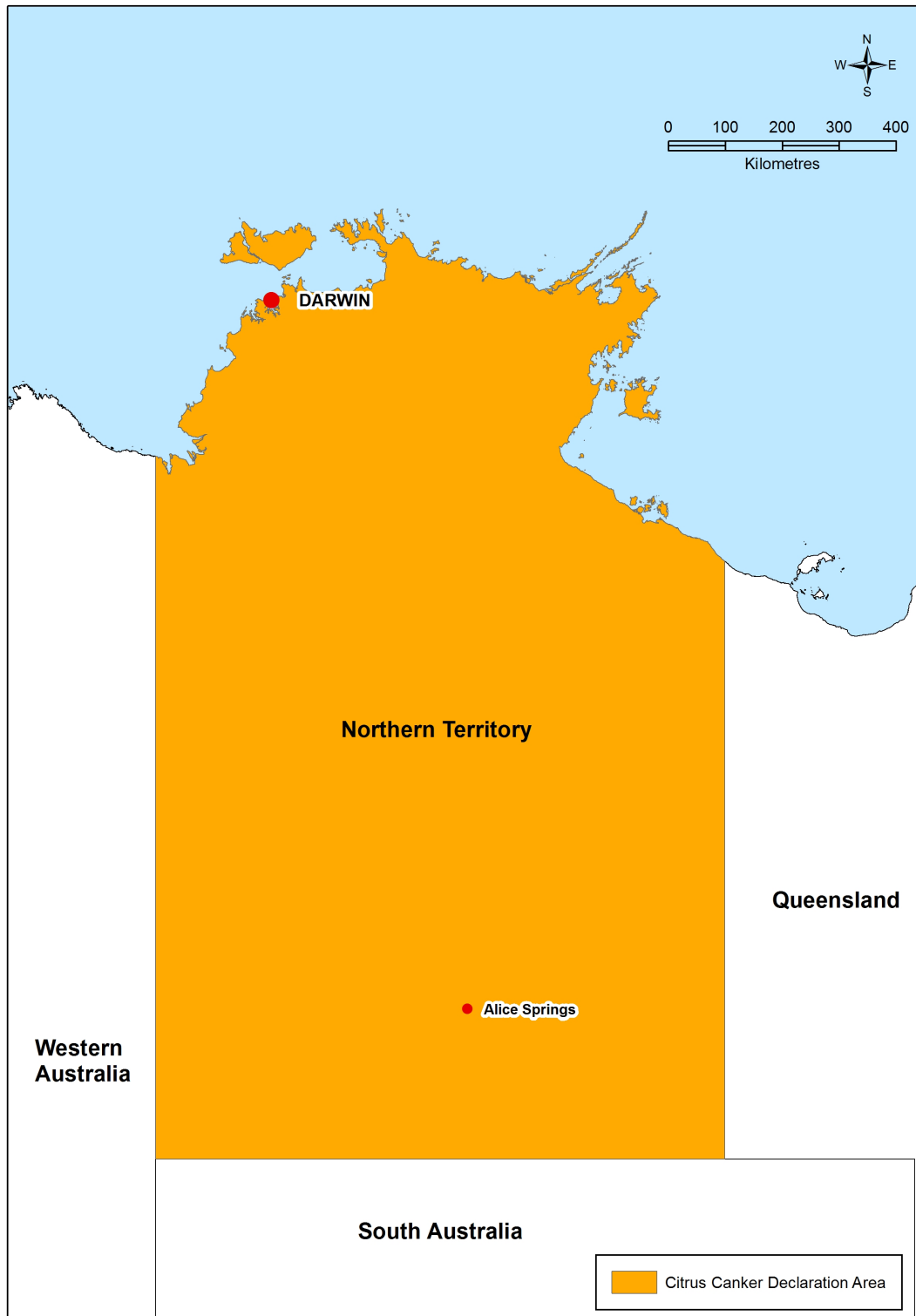
9 Expiry

This instrument expires on 1 May 2021.

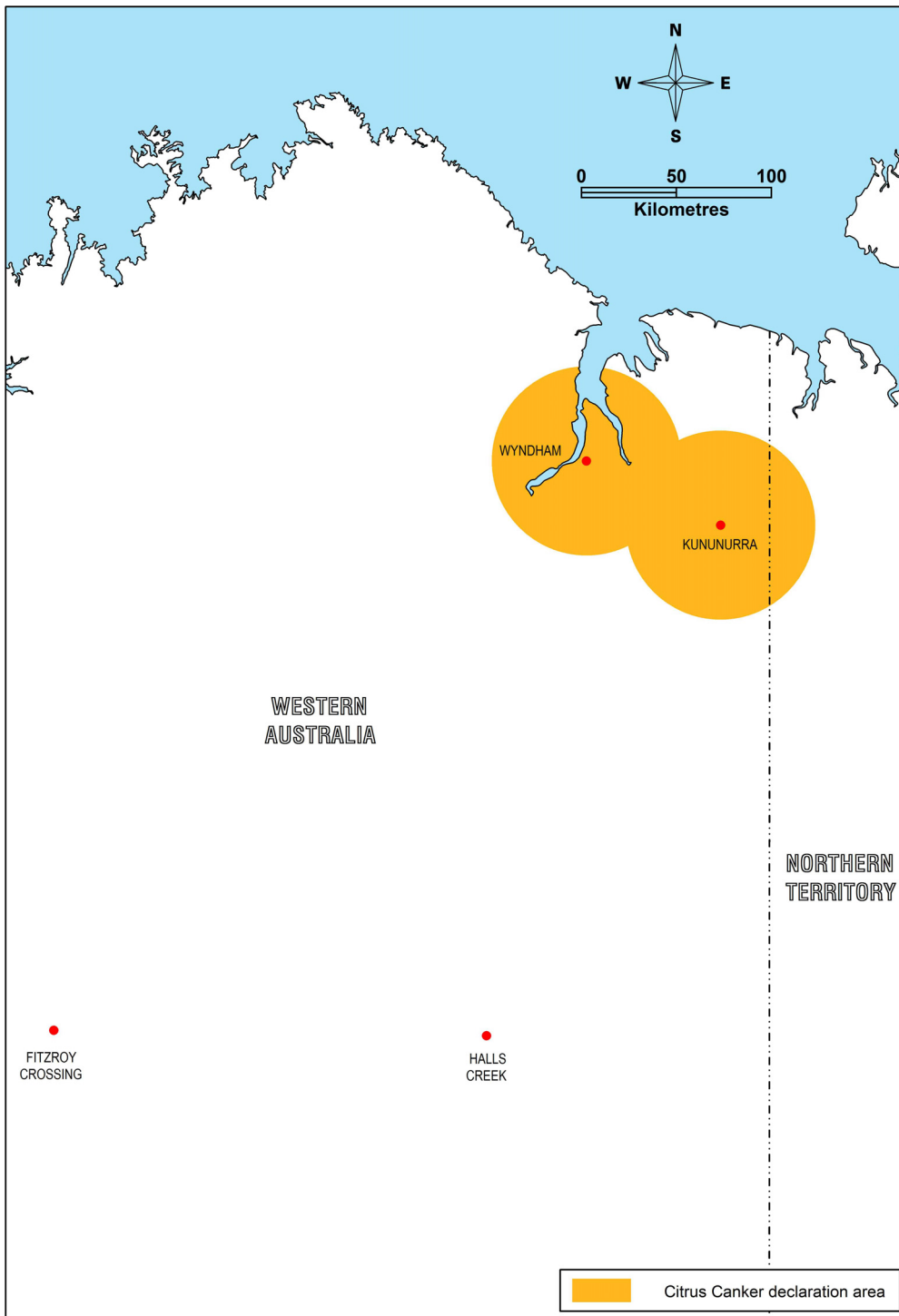

1	Citrus canker carrier	<p>The import into the ACT from the declared area of any citrus canker carrier is prohibited unless:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">a. In the case of citrus plants (including fruit and leaves), soil and packaging, the Citrus canker carrier was grown in or sourced from in a State or Territory, or part of a State or Territory, for which an area freedom certificate is currently in force.b. In the case of machinery or equipment, the Citrus canker carrier has been used or operated solely in States or Territory, or parts of a State or Territory, for which an area freedom certificate is currently in force.c. The Citrus canker carrier has been processed or treated in a manner to prevent transmission of Citrus canker
