

Major Events (Domain Cricket Test Match) Declaration 2018 (No 1)

Disallowable instrument DI2018—280

made under the

Major Events Act 2014, s 6 (Major event – declaration)

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Major Events (Domain Cricket Test Match) Declaration 2018 (No 1)*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after its notification.

3 Declaration of Major Events—Act, s 6 (1) and s 7 (1) (a)

The test match between Australia and Sri Lanka, to be held at Manuka Oval on 1 February 2019 to 5 February 2019, is declared to be a major event.

4. Event organiser—Act, s 7 (1) (b)

The organiser of the major event is Cricket Australia.

5. Proposed date—Act, s 7 (1) (c)

The proposed date of this major event is 1 February 2019 to 5 February 2019.

6. Proposed time—Act, s 7 (1) (c)

The proposed times of the major event are as follows:

(a) Friday 1 February 2019;

- i. From 9:00 am when the gates open; to
- ii. 5.30 pm when the match is scheduled to finish

(b) Saturday 2 February 2019;

- i. From 9:00 am when the gates open; to
- ii. 5:30 pm when the match is scheduled to finish

(c) Sunday 3 February 2019;

- i. From 9:30 am when the gates open; to
- ii. 5:30 pm when the match is scheduled to finish

- (d) Monday 4 February 2019;
 - i. From 9:30 am when the gates open; to
 - ii. 5:30 pm when the match is scheduled to finish

- (e) Tuesday 5 February 2019;
 - i. From 9:30 am when the gates open; to
 - ii. 5:30 pm when the match is scheduled to finish.

7. Event venue—Act, s 7 (1) (d)

The proposed location of the venue for the major event are the grounds, including any buildings situated on the grounds, occupied by Manuka Oval, Manuka Circle, Griffith ACT 2603.

8. When notice is in force—Act, s 7 (1) (e)

This notice is in effect for the period beginning at 12:01 am on 1 February 2019 and ending at 12:01 am on 6 February 2019.

9. Notice given under other provisions—Act, s 26 (1) and s 32 (1)

Notice will be given under the following provisions for the event:

- (a) Notice of protected symbols –Act, s 26
 - i. Protected symbols will be notified for the duration of this instrument.
- (b) Notice of clean zone – Act, s 32
 - ii. A clean zone will be notified for the duration of this instrument.

10. Meaning of prohibited item —Act, s 12 (1) (b)

In addition to the items listed under s 12(1)(a) of the Act, the following items are prohibited under s 12(1)(b) of the Act:

- (a) tripods, monopods or lenses with a total focal strength of greater than 200mm;
- (b) commercial digital video camera equipment; and
- (c) cameras or other type of photographic or recording devices (of any nature whatsoever and whether capable of capturing still or moving pictures) other than for recreational and personal non-commercial use.

11. Expiry

This instrument expires at 12:01 am on 6 February 2019.
