Animal Diseases (Endemic Diseases) Declaration 2018

Animal Diseases Act 2005, section 16 (Declaration of endemic disease)

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Animal Diseases (Endemic Diseases) Declaration 2018*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after its notification day.

3 Declaration

I declare the diseases listed in schedule 1 to be endemic diseases.

4 Revocation

The *Animal Diseases (Endemic Diseases) Declaration 2014 (No 1)* (DI2014—289) is revoked.

SCHEDULE 1 - ENDEMIC DISEASES

Mammalian Diseases

Cysticercus bovis (*Taenia saginata*)
Equine herpes - virus 1 (abortigenic strain)
Footrot in sheep and goats
Paratuberculosis (Johne's disease)
Tuberculosis (mammalian or avian)

Avian Diseases

Avian influenza (low pathogenicity)
Avian tuberculosis
Paramyxovirus PMV -1 in pigeons

Bee Diseases

American foulbrood (*Paenibacillus larvae*)
European foulbrood (*Melissococcus pluton*)
Nosemosis (*Nosema apis* and *Nosema ceranae*)

Finfish Diseases

Aeromonas salmonicida atypical strains (Goldfish ulcer disease)
Epizootic ulcerative syndrome (*Aphanomyces invadans*)
Epizootic haematopoietic necrosis – EHN virus
Viral encephalopathy and retinopathy

Crustacean Diseases

Thelohaniosis of crustaceans

Amphibians

Infection with *Batrachochytrium dendrobatidis*
Infection with ranavirus
