1 Name of instrument
This instrument is the Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Maximum Fares for Taxi Services Determination 2019 (No 2).

## 2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 1 November 2019.

## 3 Determination

I determine that the maximum fares relating to the hiring or use of a taxi are as specified in schedule 1 to this instrument.

4 Payment of Fare
A fare to which this determination applies is payable by a customer for using taxi services and is payable to the taxi driver with the exception of the lift fee, which is payable by the ACT Government to the taxi driver.

## 5 Revocation

This instrument revokes:
(a) Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Maximum Fares for Taxi Services Determination 2017 (No 1) DI2017-247; and
(b) Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Maximum Fares for Taxi Services Determination 2019 DI2019-222.
