

# Road Transport (General) Application of Road Transport Legislation Declaration 2020 (No 1)

## Disallowable instrument DI2020–19

made under the

***Road Transport (General) Act 1999, section 12 (Power to include or exclude areas in road transport legislation)***

### 1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Road Transport (General) Application of Road Transport Legislation Declaration 2020 (No 1)*.

### 2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 20 February 2020.

### 3 Declaration

We declare that the following provisions of the *Road Transport (Road Rules) Regulation 2017* do not apply to the areas identified in the schedules to this instrument:

- (a) Section 205 (Parking for longer than indicated);
- (b) Section 205A (Parking outside time indicated);
- (c) Section 207 (Parking where fee payable);
- (d) Section 208 (Parallel parking on road);
- (e) Section 208A (Parallel parking in road related area);
- (f) Section 211 (Parking in parking bay);
- (g) Section 213I (Ticket parking – parking in space);
- (h) Section 213J (Ticket parking – parking in space – motorbike);
- (i) Section 213K (Ticket parking – display of ticket); and
- (j) Section 213M (Ticket parking – maximum length of stay).

#### **4 Period of effect of declaration**

The declaration has effect during the following periods:

- (a) The declaration has effect in the areas identified in schedule 1 during the period commencing at 6:00am on Thursday, 20 February 2020 and ending at 12:01am on Monday, 24 February 2020
- (b) The declaration has effect in the areas identified in schedule 2 during the period commencing at 12:01am on Friday, 21 February 2020 and ending at 6:00am on Monday, 24 February 2020.

#### **5 Expiry**

This instrument expires on 25 February 2020.
