1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Liquor* (*Public Health Emergency—Permit Fee Waiver*) *Declaration 2020.*

2 Commencement

This instrument is taken to have commenced on 25 March 2020.

3 Waiver of fees

Pursuant to section 35 of the *Liquor Regulation 2010*, I waive each permit fee listed in column 1 in the table at Schedule 1 of this instrument. The permit fee is waived for the period listed in column 2. Any conditions of the waiver are listed in column 3.
