1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Liquor* (*Public Health Emergency—Licence Fee Waiver*) *Declaration* 2020.

2 Commencement

This instrument is taken to have commenced on 1 April 2020.

3 Waiver of fees

Pursuant to section 35 of the *Liquor Regulation 2010*, I waive each licence fee listed in column 1 in the table at Schedule 1 of this instrument. The licence fee is waived for the period listed in column 2. Any conditions of the waiver are listed in column 3.

Each waiver is appropriate because of the financial impact of the emergency declaration under the *Public Health Act 1997*, section 119 (Emergency declarations) on the business carried on under the licence or permit.

A fee in the *Liquor* (*Fees*) *Determination* 2019 (DI2019-159), mentioned in schedule 1, column 1, that is payable during the period mentioned in column 2, is waived if the condition mentioned in column 3 is met.
