### 1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Liquor (COVID-19 Emergency Response – Permit Fee Waiver) Declaration 2021 (No 4)*.

### 2 Commencement

A fee in the *Liquor (Fees) Determination 2021* [DI2021-144], mentioned in schedule 1, column 1, that is payable during the period mentioned in column 2, is waived if the condition mentioned in column 3 is met.
