Circular Economy Act 2023, section 23 (Minister may disapply Act for person or prohibited product)

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Circular Economy (Prohibited Products) Exemption Declaration 2023 (No 1)*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day the *Circular Economy Act 2023* (the Act), section 3 commences.

3 Exemption

- (1) The Act, division 3.2 (Supplying prohibited products) does not apply to a prohibited product stated in the schedule.
- (2) In accordance with the Act, section 23 (3), I am satisfied that disapplication of the Act, division 3.2 will not have any significant adverse effect on public health, property, or the environment.

4 Expiry

This instrument expires on 31 October 2024.

Plastic-lined paper plates	A paper or cardboard plate that has a plastic lining or coating but does not otherwise contain plastic.
Plastic-lined paper bowls	A paper or cardboard bowl that that has a plastic lining or coating but does not otherwise contain plastic.
