Circular Economy Act 2023, s 21 (Minister may declare prohibitable product must not be supplied at public event)

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Circular Economy (Public Event) Declaration 2023 (No 1)*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day the *Circular Economy Act 2023* (the Act), section 3 commences.

3 Declared public event

I declare the events listed in column 1 of table 1 in the Schedule to be public events to which division 3.3 of the Act applies.

4 Declared prohibitable products

I declare that the products listed in column 3 of table 1 in the Schedule must not be supplied at events listed in the corresponding row of column 1.
