

Road Transport (General) Application of Road Transport Legislation Declaration 2023 (No 5)

Disallowable instrument DI2023–63

made under the

Road Transport (General) Act 1999, section 13 (Power to exclude vehicles, persons or animals from road transport legislation)

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Road Transport (General) Application of Road Transport Legislation Declaration 2023 (No 5)*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 10 May 2023.

3 Declarations – public passenger services

- (a) I declare that the *Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Act 2001*, except part 8A (additional public passenger vehicle insurance), does not apply to an accredited operator in relation to the operation by the operator of a designated vehicle.
- (b) I declare that the *Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Act 2001* does not apply to the driver of, or a passenger in, a designated vehicle operated by an accredited operator.

4 Declaration – public vehicle licence

I declare that the *Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Act 1999* does not apply to the driver of a designated vehicle operated by an accredited operator to the extent that the driver is required to hold a public vehicle licence.

5 Definitions

In this instrument:

accredited operator – despite section 3, see *Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Regulation 2002*, dictionary.

designated vehicle – means a vehicle (including a bus and hire car) driven for the purposes of transporting members of the USA Special Visitors Program in

May 2023.

hire car – see *Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Act 2001*, section 67.

bus – see *Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Act 2001*, section 10A.

6 Expiry

This instrument expires on 26 May 2023.
