1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Domestic Animals (Prohibited Areas) Declaration 2024 (No 1)**.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after notification.

3 Declaration

I declare the locations marked in red on the ‘Dog Exercise Areas’ map at schedule 1 as prohibited areas for dogs.

4 Revocation

This instrument revokes the *Domestic Animals (Prohibited Areas) Declaration 2021 (No 1)* (DI2021-231).

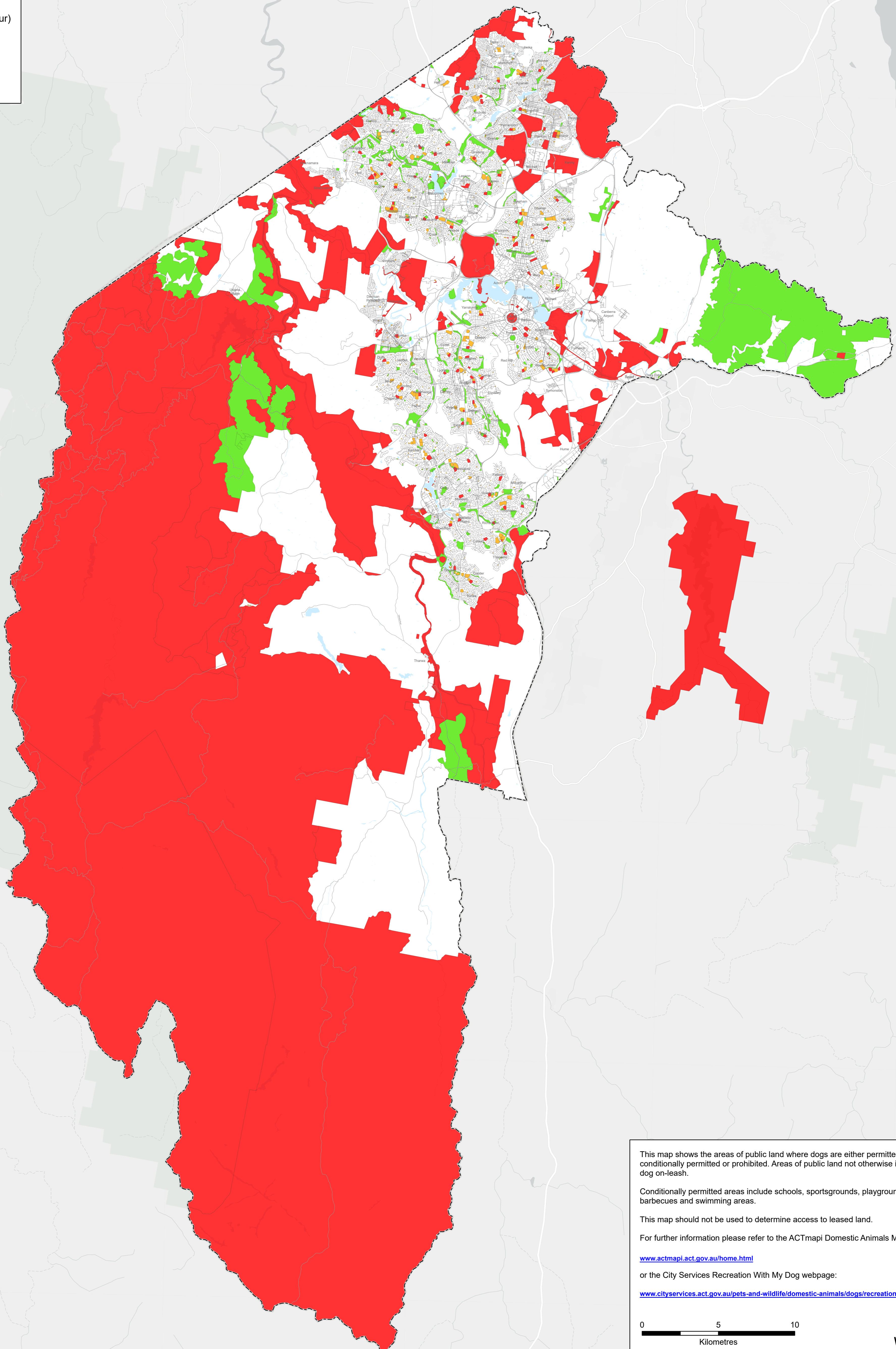
