1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Professional Engineers (Fees) Determination 2026*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 1 July 2026.

3 Determination of fees

Note 1 The figures in column 4 are for comparison purposes only.

Note 2 The application fee for registration if the application is made under the principles of mutual recognition, under item 5 includes Australian jurisdictions and New Zealand. Australian jurisdictions are covered by the *Mutual Recognition Act 1992* (Cth). New Zealand is covered by the Trans-Tasman Mutual Recognition arrangements

Formula for non-standard registration term

(1) The fee payable for a registration issued for a period less than 3 years is the amount worked out in accordance with the following formula:

(F/36) x N where

F is the 3-year registration fee; and

N is the number of months, and part months, rounded up to the nearest number of whole months for which the registration is to be issued or renewed.

Example:

Elizabeth's registration is issued for a period of 2 years, 3 months and 2 weeks. For the formula **N** is 28. This is because there are 24 months in a 2-year period and the 3 months and 2 weeks is rounded up to 4 months, making a total of 28 months.

Note An example is part of the instrument, is not exhaustive and may extend, but does not limit, the meaning of the provision in which it appears (see Legislation Act, s 126 (4) and s 132).
