**DETERMINATION NO. 296 OF 1996**

**EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

This instrument revokes Determination No. 121 of 1996 as notified in ACT Gazette No. S144 of 27 June 1996.

This instrument determines fees under the Building and Services Act 1924 for the purpose of charging for garbage disposed of at ACT Government landfills

The fees are set out in the Schedule to the instrument.

The level of commercial fees has been set in accordance with the cost of providing appropriate garbage disposal facilities, including the likely future cost of replacement or alternative facilities.

The non-commercial waste disposal levy will be used to fund the administration of the levy, related matters and waste management activities focusing on waste minimisation.
