Race and Sports Bookmaking - Sports Bookmaking Venue Determination 2002 (No 1)

Disallowable instrument DI2002—6

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Race and Sports Bookmaking Act 2001* (the Act) governs the activities of sports bookmakers in the Australian Capital Territory.

Part 3 of the Act provides for the conduct and control of sports bookmaking. In particular, section 21(1) of the Act provides that the Commission may determine a place to be a sports bookmaking venue for the purpose of the Act.

The sports bookmaking venue this determination relates to is the ground floor of the Acton Stand of the Canberra Racecourse, Block 2, Section 69, Division of Lyneham and is identified as the shaded areas on the plan attached to the determination.

This instrument revokes Determination No. 266 of 2001, notified in Gazette No S68 of 7 September 2001, and includes the lounge area.
