## EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

## DISALLOWABLE INSTRUMENT FOR THE PURPOSES OF SECTION 10 BETTING (TOTALIZATOR ADMINISTRATION) ACT 1964

## DETERMINATION NO.32 OF 1993

Section 10 of the Betting (Totalizator Administration) Act (the Act) 1964 specifies that the Minister may declare a race club to be a declared race club. A 'race club' is defined in the Act as being a club formed or carried on for the purpose of conducting or controlling races in the Territory.

Section 11 of the Act specifies that a determination made for the purpose of section 10 of the Act shall be a disallowable instrument for the purposes of section 10 of the Subordinate Laws Act 1989.

Determination No.32 of 1993 declares the following clubs to be declared race clubs:

- ACT Racing Club Inc.
- Canberra Greyhound Racing Club Inc.
- . Canberra Harness Racing Club Inc.
