DETERMINATION OF TYPES OF LIQUOR

NO. 23 OF 1993

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The Business Franchise (Liquor) Act 1993 (the Act) provides for the payment of fees for liquor trading in the ACT.

The Act also provides for different rates for different types of liquor.

Section 23 of the Act provides for the Minister to determine the types of liquor applicable to the calculation of franchise fees. There are two types of liquor provided for in this determination, alcohol products over 3.5% alcohol/volume, and alcohol products of alcohol/volume of 3.5% or less.

This Determination therefore provides for the determined type of liquor referred to in sections 9(2) and 17(1) of the Act.
