PUBLIC PLACE NAMES ACT 1989

DETERMINATION NO. 5 OF 1993

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Public Place Names Act provides for the naming of divisions and public places and, in particular, section 4 empowers the Minister, by notice published in the Gazette, to determine the name of a division or public place.

Under section 4 of the Public Place names Act 1989, I revoke the street name Windsor Walk in the Divisions of Barton and Forrest as the road is to be closed. Therefore, the street name is no longer necessary and could be used in a different location at a later date.

Pursuant to section 5 of the Administration Act 1989 the Minister has delegated the power under the Public Place names Act 1989 to name a division or public place to the Secretary of the Department of the Environment, Land and Planning.

Schedule 'A' of the Determination, together with the accompanying map, details the name origin and significance of Windsor Walk in the Divisions of Barton and Forrest.

Schedule 'B' of the Determination revokes Windsor Walk in the Divisions of Barton and Forrest.
