**DETERMINATION OF FEES**

**EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

**DETERMINATION No. 80 OF 1993.**

This Determination made under Section 116 of the Unit Titles Act 1970 varies the fees for the purposes of the Unit Titles Act 1970 viz.

**. Section II - Proposals for sub-division**

A lessee may apply to the Minister for approval for a proposal for the sub-division of a lease under the Unit Titles Act 1970, provided the sub-division is for not less than four units and common property, and

(a) where the applicant does not intend to apply for approval under Section 16 prior to completion of the building works and where,

(i) the number of residential units is two	1,000	1,000
(ii) the number of residential units is three	1,600	1,600
(iii) the number of commercial units is two to three	1,600	1,600
(iv) the number of units exceeds three but does not exceed 50	1,600	1,600

**plus \$110 (\$105 in 1991) for each unit in excess of 4 units.**

(v) the number of units exceeds 50  plus \$100 (\$95 in 1991) for each unit in excess of 50 units.	6,600	6,600

(b) where the applicant intends to apply for approval under Section 16 prior to completion of the building works and where,

(i) the number of residential units is three	2,000	2,000
(ii) the number of commercial units is two to three	2,000	2,000
(iii) the number of units exceeds three but does not exceed fifty  plus \$120 (\$115 in 1991) for each unit in excess of 4 units	2,000	2,000
(iv) the number of units exceeds 50  plus \$120 (\$115 in 1991) for each unit in excess of 50 units	7,500	7,500

. **Section 16 - Approval of Sub-division** applies where a lessee seeks the approval of a sub-division prior to the completion of building works on the lease and has not applied (and paid the accompanying fee) under Section 11.
