DETERMINATION OF FEES

*Determination No. 43 of 1992.*

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This instrument revokes all existing fees determinations under the Agents Act 1968 relating to fees payable in respect to the issue and renewal of licence and registration fees payable in respect to real estate agents, business agents, stock and station agents and travel agents.

This increase is based on a Government decision on 17 June 1991 that all fees not brought forward for Cabinet consideration would be increased by the CPI. The parameter used in the review of fees and charges was 5.2%. This estimate has now been revised to 4.0%.

This instrument (copy attached) sets fees for the purpose of the Agents Act 1968 including:

- . annual fees payable by a travel agent to be paid in respect of a company as well as an individual;
- . the payment of fees where a real estate agent or travel agent elects to increase or decrease the number of places of business; and
- . the payment of a fee for the issue of an amended licence.
