PUBLIC PLACES NAMES ACT 1989

DETERMINATION NO. 45 OF 1992

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Public Place Names Act 1989, provides for the naming of divisions and public places and, in particular, section 4 empowers the Minister, by notice published in the Gazette, to determine the name of a division or public place.

Pursuant to section 5 of the Administration Act 1989 the Minister has delegated the power under the Public Place Names Act 1989 to name a division or public place to the Secretary of the Department of the Environment Land and Planning.

The Determination, together with an accompanying map, details the name of the public place which, by virtue of section 3 of the Public Place Names Act 1989, includes an avenue or a road, street or place which the public are entitled to use and any unleased land.

Schedule A of the Determination shows the new plan layout of the affected street within the Gordon Development.

Schedule B of the Determination revokes the name of a street in the Division of Gordon. Previously, the road was gazetted as a "circuit" however it is more correctly identified as a "crescent".

Schedule C of the Determination varies the location of a street. The original street development did not go ahead and the name has been reused in a different location.
