DETERMINATION OF FEES

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This instrument sets fees for the purposes of the Ozone Protection Act 1991. The fees are set out below.

The Ozone Protection Act 1991 provides for the issuing of licences to deal with, manufacture or use an ozone depleting substance or service an article which contains an ozone depleting substance.

A calculation of the costs of issuing the licence and minimum follow up inspections is attached. Based on these calculations the cost an ACT licence for service personnel and business premises would be \$50.

The calculated fee is similar to that of South Australia and Victoria and is considerably less than the fee charged by the NSW Environment Protection Authority.

The licence application fee for wholesalers is nil as the licence renewal fee will be based on the quantity of CFCs sold in the previous 12 months.
