DETERMINATION OF FEES 1992

DETERMINATION NO. 80 OF 1992

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Under section 7 of the Pounds Act 1928 the Minister may determine fees and charges for the purposes of this Act.

This determination sets pound fees, driving charges, deterrent fees, trespass rates, sustenance fees, and inspection of books fees under the Act. The fees are set out below, the amounts in brackets are the previous charges.

Inspection of Books:

(a)	in the case of a request to inspect the pound book for any period not earlier than 6 months preceding the date of the request, or to inspect the Act and Regulations	3.75 (3.65) for each period of 10 minutes or part of 10 minutes that the book is inspected, with a minimum fee of 5.35 (5.20)

- (b) in the case of a request to inspect the pound book for any period earlier than 6 months preceding the date of the request 5.35 (5.20) for each period of 10 minutes or part of 10 minutes that the book is inspected.
- (a) for an extract or copy of an entry in the pound book relating to an impounding made not earlier than 6 months preceding the date on which the extract or copy is applied for or for an extract or copy of an entry in the register of brands 3.75 (3.65)
- b) for an extract or copy of an entry in the pound book relating to an impounding made earlier than 6 months preceding the date on which the extract or copy is applied for 4.30 (4.15)
