EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This determination sets fees for the purpose of the Motor Traffic Act 1936 and has the purpose of varying the fee for the parking of a Motor vehicle in the carpark situated upon Block 9 Section 3 in the Division of Phillip. The new fee ends the inconsistency between fees charged at this and adjacent carparks.

The fee is set out with the existing fee in the left column and the new fee to the right.
