EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This instrument revokes all existing fees determinations under section 4A of the Machinery Act 1949, namely

Determination notice dated 3 October 1990 published in Australian Capital Territory Gazette No. 39.

This determination sets fees for the purposes of the Machinery Act 1949 and has the effect of increasing fees for the annual inspection of boilers and pressure vessels and the issue of boiler attendant's certificates. The fees are set out below with previous fees shown in brackets.
