AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY PUBLIC PLACE NAMES ACT 1989 DETERMINATION NO OF 1991

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Public Place Names Act 1989 provides for the naming of divisions and public places and, in particular, section 4 empowers the Minister, by notice published in the Gazette, to determine the name of a division or public place.

Pursuant to section 5 of the Administration Act 1989 the Chief Minister has delegated the power under the Public Place Names Act 1989 to name a division or public place to the person for the time being holding or performing the duties of Position Number 13025, Department of the Environment Land and Planning.

Schedule A of the Determination, together with accompanying maps, details the names of various public places which, by virtue of section 3 of the Public Place Names Act 1989, includes an avenue or a road, street or place which the public are entitled to use.

Schedule B of the Determination revokes the names of a number of streets in the division of Gordon. Previously, non-standard identifiers were assigned and this gazettal now standardises these streets with all other Camberra nomenclature.
